2009/10 Player Registration Process

Players eligible to participate in the Central California Soccer League (CCSL) must be registered with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Registration of players will be centralized at CCSL with the Registrar Dodie Gallegos. The CCSL will collect \$25 for each player's registration processed. \$21 will go to the California Soccer Association – North (CSAN) for each player pass to cover insurance and processing fees. \$4 will be retained by the CCSL for processing. Teams will be allowed to register up to 24 players. However, only 18 players are allowed to participate in any given game. Teams are also allowed to carry 2 additional players on their injury list for a maximum period of 30 days with proper verification by a Physician. To add a player to an already full team roster and comply with the 24-player limit, an active player must be released. The processing fee for each USSF release form is \$5. Players are only allowed to register with one team and will have to be properly released before they can sign with another team.

At the beginning of the season, players are required to complete and sign a USSF player registration form. Registration forms for first-time applicants must include a color passport-size photo. Returning players registration forms should include last year's player pass. Completed registration forms and payment should be submitted to the Registrar for processing at:

The Registrar will maintain an up to date roster of the registered players in each team participating in the league. The Registrar will forward completed forms and appropriate payment to CSAN for the processing. CSAN will generate the laminated player passes and will send them to the CCSL Registrar. Once the Registrar receives the player passes from CSAN, she will place the "yellow card tracking sticker" on the back of each pass and promptly distribute them to the appropriate Team Manager.

Completed player registration forms to add players during the regular season and player release forms when necessary will be required to be turned into the CCSL Registrar by Sunday, for that particular player to receive his laminated player pass from CSAN and be eligible to play the following Sunday. CSAN has agreed to send player passes to CCSL within that week, if the completed Player Registration form is received by CSAN postmarked Monday of any given week.

Player passes will be required for participation in all CCSL official game.

Under extremely unusual circumstances, **a player who is properly registered** and which for no fault of his own the player pass is not available, may be allowed to participate in an official game. However, only the CCSL President, Vice President or Registrar will be allowed to make that determination and will be required to contact the assigned referee to indicate that a particular player may be allowed to participate in a specific game using some type of official identification (i.e. driver license, passport, etc.). The League will take immediate action to correct that situation and prevent it from happening again.
